# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO INTERNATIONAL EDUCATION PROGRAMS.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the University of

2 Hawaii Maui College, in partnership with local businesses, will

3 be sending its first cohort of "New Sakadas" to leading

4 universities in the Philippines to provide selected students an

5 educational and cultural experience in a nation with the tenth

6 fastest growing economy of 2017. The University of Hawaii-West

7 Oahu has been exploring opportunities to send enrolled students

8 to universities in Japan, Korea, and China to enhance economic

9 and cultural opportunities for Hawaii residents in those

10 countries and the Asia-Pacific region. With a local population

11 largely made of descendants of plantation workers and immigrants

12 from the Philippines, Japan, China, Korea, and other parts of

13 the Asia-Pacific region, Hawaii's residents should take

14 advantage of these cultural and historic ties for the potential

15 economic benefit to the State. This educational opportunity

16 allows students to become familiar with nations in these regions

- 3 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds to the
- 4 University of Hawaii to fund one or more programs sponsored or
- 5 organized by the University of Hawaii community colleges or a
- 6 four-year campus to implement international college experiences
- 7 for Hawaii students enrolled at a University of Hawaii campus.
- 8 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 9 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$100,000 or so much
- 10 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2018-2019 for the
- 11 University of Hawaii to fund one or more programs sponsored or
- 12 organized by the University of Hawaii community colleges or a
- 13 four-year campus to implement international college experiences
- 14 for Hawaii students enrolled at a University of Hawaii campus.
- 15 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the University of
- 16 Hawaii, in collaboration with the department of business,
- 17 economic development, and tourism for the purposes of this Act.
- 18 SECTION 3. The University of Hawaii shall submit a report
- 19 of its findings and recommendations to the legislature no later
- 20 than twenty days prior to the convening of the regular session
- 21 of 2019. The report shall also identify the University of

- 1 Hawaii campuses that are participating in one or more of the
- 2 programs that are implementing international college experiences
- 3 for Hawaii students enrolled at a University of Hawaii campus.
- 4 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2112.
