### A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR HE'EIA NATIONAL ESTUARINE RESEARCH RESERVE.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The national estuarine research reserve system
- 2 is a network of twenty-eight protected areas along America's
- 3 coasts. According to the National Estuarine Research Reserve
- 4 System Strategic Plan 2011-2016, the system is founded on the
- 5 principle that long-term protection of representative estuaries
- 6 provides stable platforms for research and education and the
- 7 application of management practices that will benefit the
- 8 nation's estuaries and coasts.
- 9 The legislature finds that the State has coordinated with
- 10 the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration to nominate
- 11 He'eia estuary as a national estuarine research reserve. The
- 12 site, located on Oahu's windward shore, includes He'eia state
- 13 park, He'eia fishpond, and the He'eia community development
- 14 district, as well as marine waters with patch and fringing reefs
- 15 and Moku o Lo'e (Coconut Island). In 2012, the office of
- 16 planning was designated as the lead agency to coordinate the

- 1 selection for a Hawaii site to be designated as a national
- 2 estuarine research reserve and nomination process for He'eia to
- 3 be designated as a national estuarine research reserve. In
- 4 2014, He'eia was officially nominated as a national estuarine
- 5 research reserve to support the National Oceanic and Atmospheric
- 6 Administration's policy to encourage expansion of the program in
- 7 unrepresented areas of the country.
- 8 The He'eia site was chosen as the preferred site after a
- 9 statewide solicitation period from interested communities. The
- 10 office of planning supported the designation process through the
- 11 development of the He'eia national estuarine research reserve
- 12 system management plan. On January 19, 2017, the He'eia site was
- 13 officially designated as the twenty-ninth site in the national
- 14 estuarine research reserve system, which enables federal funding
- 15 to support the implementation of the management plan.
- 16 The Hawaii institute of marine biology, which is part of
- 17 the University of Hawaii at Manoa, is the lead agency for
- 18 implementation of the He'eia national estuarine research reserve
- 19 system management plan. The university's partners will include
- 20 the Hawaii community development authority, department of land
- 21 and natural resources, and several community organizations. For

- 1 He'eia reserve to succeed in its function within the national
- 2 estuarine research reserve system, funding for initial staffing
- 3 is essential. The initial staffing needs are four full-time
- 4 equivalent (4.0 FTE) positions: reserve manager, education
- 5 coordinator, research coordinator, and cultural resource
- 6 coordinator. Although the University of Hawaii has agreed to
- 7 fund these positions in the first year, further funding is
- 8 required to sustain them and to keep He'eia reserve fully
- 9 functioning. These positions must be established and sustained
- 10 to develop and manage He'eia reserve and keep it fully
- 11 functioning. The legislature notes that as funding or
- 12 partnership opportunities become available, additional staff
- 13 will be required within the first five years to meet management
- 14 plan goals and objectives, and further notes that the federal
- 15 government matches state appropriations on a seventy per cent
- 16 (federal) to thirty per cent (state) basis.
- 17 The purpose of this Act is to support He'eia estuary in its
- 18 designation as a national estuarine research reserve by
- 19 appropriating funds to maintain the initial staff necessary to
- 20 develop and manage He'eia reserve and its programs.

- 1 SECTION 2. Contractors and other third parties who receive
- 2 funds under this Act may be subject to review and inspection by
- 3 the University of Hawaii, department of land and natural
- 4 resources, the attorney general, and the auditor. Upon request
- 5 by such agencies, the contractor or third party shall be
- 6 required to submit for review all files, records, documents, and
- 7 accounting related to the use and expenditure of funds received
- 8 pursuant to this Act, whether the funds were received via
- 9 contract, grant, or other agreement.
- 10 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 11 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 12 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2018-2019 for
- 13 the hiring of 1.36 full-time equivalent (1.36 FTE) permanent
- 14 positions within the University of Hawaii to maintain the
- 15 initial staff positions that are necessary to develop and manage
- 16 He'eia reserve and its programs.
- 17 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the University of
- 18 Hawaii for the purposes of this Act.
- 19 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on December 24,
- **20** 2030.
