A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 127A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated

 and to read as follows:
- 4 "§127A- Local television stations; emergency
- 5 information; closed or open captioning. (a) Each local
- 6 television station shall make emergency information that is
- 7 provided in the audio portion of its video programming
- 8 accessible to persons with hearing disabilities by using a
- 9 method of closed or open captioning.
- 10 (b) During an emergency, the agency shall monitor the
- 11 video programming of each local television station. If a local
- 12 television station that is broadcasting emergency information
- 13 fails to comply with subsection (a), the agency shall
- 14 immediately issue a warning to the station by telephone or other
- 15 instantaneous means of communication and inform the station of
- 16 its duty to comply. If the local television station fails to
- 17 comply within minutes, the agency shall subsequently assess

- 1 and collect a fine from the station in an amount and in a manner
- 2 that complies with rules adopted by the governor pursuant to
- 3 section 127A-25.
- 4 (c) For the purposes of this section:
- 5 "Broadcast station" and "television service" shall have the
- 6 same meaning as in title 47 United States Code section 153, as
- 7 amended.
- 8 "Closed captioning" and "video programming" shall have the
- 9 same meaning as in title 47 Code of Federal Regulations section
- 10 79.1(a).
- "Emergency information" shall have the same meaning as in
- 12 title 47 Code of Federal Regulations section 79.2(a).
- "Local television station" means a broadcast station that
- 14 is located in Hawaii and provides television service.
- "Open captioning" shall have the same meaning as "closed
- 16 captioning"; provided that the technology does not require a
- 17 television viewer to use a closed caption decoder described in
- 18 subpart B of 47 Code of Federal Regulations part 79 in order to
- 19 read the captioned text."

- 1 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 2 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 3 begun before its effective date.
- 4 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 5 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2018.
