## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 127A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as follows:
4	"§127A- Accessibility of emergency information. (a)
5	The agency shall amend the state emergency alert system and
6	state emergency management plans as necessary to conform to all
7	current federal laws and regulations that ensure the
8	accessibility of video programming that provides emergency
9	information, including:
10	(1) Title 47 Code of Federal Regulations section 79.2 and
11	other regulations enforced by the Federal
12	Communications Commission; and
13	(2) Regulations enforced by the Department of Homeland
14	Security and the Federal Emergency Management Agency.
15	(b) For the purposes of this section:
16	"Emergency information" shall have the same meaning as in
<b>17</b>	title 47 Code of Federal Regulations section 79.2(a).

- 1 "Video programming" shall have the same meaning as in title
- 2 47 Code of Federal Regulations section 79.1(a)."
- 3 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 4 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 5 begun before its effective date.
- 6 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 7 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
