A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO INTERPRETER SERVICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the deaf and blind
- 2 task force's monthly meetings often require interpreters.
- 3 However, the task force receives no dedicated funding to pay for
- 4 interpreter services. In the past, legislators have used a
- 5 portion of their allowance to offset the cost of these services.
- 6 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate moneys for
- 7 interpreter services to be rendered during the deaf and blind
- 8 task force's monthly meetings.
- 9 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 10 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 11 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2018-2019 for
- 12 interpreter services to be rendered during the deaf and blind
- 13 task force's monthly meetings.
- 14 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 15 health for the purposes of this Act.

1 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2018.
