## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HOUSING ASSISTANCE.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the state rent
- 2 supplement program has proven to be effective in securing and
- 3 maintaining housing for working individuals, senior or disabled
- 4 individuals, and families who are homeless. The state rent
- 5 supplement program provides a relatively shallow, but sustained,
- 6 rental subsidy to enable vulnerable households or those at
- 7 imminent risk of homelessness to close the rental affordability
- 8 gap, maintain housing, and achieve self-sufficiency.
- 9 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds to support
- 10 the state rent supplement program.
- 11 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 12 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of S or so
- 13 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2018-2019 for
- 14 the state rent supplement program.
- The sum appropriated shall be expended by the Hawaii public
- 16 housing authority for the purposes of this Act.
- 17 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2050.
