A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HOUSING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that individuals with 2 special needs face significant obstacles in obtaining suitable, 3 long-term affordable housing. According to the 2016 Hawaii housing planning study, many individuals with special needs have 4 difficulty in securing long-term affordable housing because of 5 their low incomes and their need for easily accessible 6 supportive services. Many housing options suitable for 7 8 individuals with special needs are only temporary, which impedes their ability to live independently for a significant period of 9 10 time. 11 The legislature further finds that the State's ability to formulate strategies to enable persons with special needs to 12 13 secure suitable and affordable housing is hindered by the lack

- 3 SECTION 2. (a) The Hawaii housing finance and development
- 4 corporation shall conduct a study to:
- 5 (1) Estimate the number of individuals with special needs
- 6 in Hawaii, including but not limited to frail elderly
- 7 individuals, persons with physical or severe mental
- 8 disabilities, persons transitioning from
- 9 incarceration, emancipated foster youth, persons with
- 10 an alcohol or drug addiction, persons with HIV/AIDS,
- 11 and victims of domestic violence, who are in need of
- 12 housing;
- 13 (2) Identify the supportive services that individuals with
- 14 special needs require and inventory the number of
- 15 providers of supportive services in each county;
- 16 (3) Develop an information system to forecast and monitor
- the number of individuals with special needs who are
- 18 seeking affordable housing; and
- 19 (4) Develop effective strategies to assist individuals
- with special needs in accessing and retaining
- affordable housing in independent settings.

- 1 The Hawaii housing finance and development corporation shall
- 2 consult with community stakeholders to identify any other issues
- 3 that should be included in the study's scope of work.
- 4 (b) The Hawaii housing finance and development corporation
- 5 shall submit a written report of its findings and
- 6 recommendations, including any necessary proposed legislation,
- 7 to the legislature no later than twenty days prior to the
- 8 convening of the regular session of 2019.
- 9 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 10 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$50,000 or so much
- 11 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2018-2019 for the
- 12 purposes of this Act.
- 13 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the Hawaii
- 14 housing finance and development corporation.
- 15 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2050.
