RELATING TO ELECTION CAMPAIGN REPORTING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 11-339, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows: 3 "[f] §11-339[] Final election period report for candidate 4 committee] Candidate committees or noncandidate [committee] committees receiving and expending \$1,000 or less [during the] 5 6 in an election period. (a) Any provision of law to the 7 contrary notwithstanding, a candidate committee or noncandidate 8 committee whose aggregate contributions and aggregate 9 expenditures for the election period total \$1,000 or less, shall 10 electronically file only a final election period report, and need not file a preliminary and final primary report, a 11 12 preliminary and final general report, or a special election 13 report. 14 (b) By June 30 of an election year, a candidate who does 15 not intend to receive or spend contributions and expenditures 16 that aggregate more than \$1,000 during the election period,

shall notify the commission of its intention by checking the

- 3 (c) By the fifth calendar day prior to the due date of the
- 4 preliminary primary report, a noncandidate committee that does
- 5 not intend to receive or spend contributions and expenditures
- 6 that aggregate more than \$1,000 during the election period shall
- 7 notify the commission of its intention by checking the
- 8 appropriate box in the noncandidate committee's organizational
- 9 report.
- 10 [(b)] (d) Until the candidate committee's or noncandidate
- 11 committee's registration is terminated as provided in section
- 12 11-326, supplemental reports and other reports required by this
- 13 part shall be filed."
- 14 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 15 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 16 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
