

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO GRANTS AND SUBSIDIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
 and to read as follows:

 "§42F- Expending agency delegation. (a) With the
 approval of the governor, the designated expending agency for a
 grant or subsidy may delegate its expending authority to a
- 7 different agency when it is determined advantageous to do so by
- 8 both the original expending agency and the agency to which the
- 9 expending authority is to be delegated; provided that the entity
- 10 to which the grant was awarded consents in advance to the
- 11 transfer of expending authority.
- 12 (b) The governor shall notify the legislature within five
- 13 days of each use of this authority and submit a report to the
- 14 legislature of all uses of this authority for the previous
- twelve month period from December 1 to November 30 no later than
- 16 twenty days prior to the convening of the subsequent regular
- 17 session. Following the delegation pursuant to this section, the

- 1 agency to which the expending authority was delegated shall be
- 2 considered the expending agency for the purposes of this
- 3 chapter."
- 4 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2017.
