4	shall ser	ve four-year-old children, with priority extended to:
5	(1)	Children who are not eligible to attend public school
6		kindergarten in the calendar year in which they turn
7		five years of age because their birth date occurs
8		after the kindergarten eligibility date pursuant to
9		section 302A-411; and
10	(2)	Underserved or at-risk children[+], as defined in
11		section 302L-1; provided that priority shall be given
12		to children whose family income is at or below two
13		hundred fifty per cent of the federal poverty level."

16	SECT	ION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2051.

Preschool Open Doors Program; At-risk Children; Underserved Children

Description:

Clarifies the definition of "underserved" or "at-risk" children as it relates to the priority given to these children for the Preschool Open Doors program. Provides that priority among undeserved or at-risk children shall be given to children whose family income is at or below 250 per cent of the federal poverty level. Takes effect 7/1/2051. (SD1)
