A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that diversifying
- 2 Hawaii's economy is critical to the future of the State.
- Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to establish the
- 4 high-growth grant program within the department of business,
- 5 economic development, and tourism to assist qualified businesses
- 6 by providing grants for specific business development purposes.
- 7 SECTION 2. Chapter 201, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 8 amended by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately
- 9 designated and to read as follows:
- 10 "§201- High-growth grant program; high-growth grant
- 11 program special fund; established. (a) There is established
- 12 within the department a business development grant program that
- 13 shall be known as the high-growth grant program. The high-
- 14 growth grant program shall assist qualified businesses by
- 15 providing grants to:
- 16 (1) Expand business operations;
- 17 (2) Improve business productivity; or

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2 The department shall issue grants under the high-(b) 3 growth grant program to finance: 4 (1) Equipment purchases; (2) 5 Management and workforce training; 6 (3) Infrastructure improvements; and 7 (4) Consulting or feasibility studies. 8 (c) There is established in the state treasury the high-9 growth grant program special fund to be administered by the 10 department and into which shall be deposited appropriations made by the legislature to the fund. Moneys in the special fund 11 12 shall be used for the purposes of this section. 13 The high-growth grant program shall provide grants to 14 qualified businesses in an amount no greater than twenty per 15 cent of the amount that is privately invested in a business for

- 1 (f) As used in this section, "qualified business" means a 2 business that has: 3 (1) Been in business for at least two full years; and 4 (2) Demonstrated the ability to export products." 5 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general 6 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much 7 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2017-2018 and the 8 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 9 2018-2019 to be deposited into the high-growth grant program 10 special fund. 11 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the high-growth 12 grant program special fund the sum of \$ or so much 13 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2017-2018 and the 14 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year **15** 2018-2019 for the high-growth grant program to provide grants to **16** qualified businesses; provided that no more than \$100,000 may be **17** used to administer the program in any fiscal year. 18 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department 19 of business, economic development, and tourism for the purposes
