A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HIGH TECHNOLOGY DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The high technology development corporation is
- 2 a key state agency in developing and supporting an innovation
- 3 industry in the State. Last year the legislature extended the
- 4 lapsing date of a previous appropriation and appropriated
- 5 additional funding for the Hawaii small business innovation
- 6 research program. The legislature believes that continuing the
- 7 program is important to supporting the innovation industry.
- 8 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 9 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 10 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2017-2018 and the
- 11 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
- 12 2018-2019 for the purpose of continuing the Hawaii small
- 13 business innovation research program; provided that the high
- 14 technology development corporation shall plan on providing
- 15 grants and loans for phase III awards where applicable.
- 16 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the high
- 17 technology development corporation for the purposes of this Act.

1 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
