A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the State lacks a
- 2 plan to capitalize on fast-evolving broadband technology that
- 3 will improve the State's outcomes in information access,
- 4 economic development, education, and communications.
- 5 The purpose of this Act is to authorize the establishment
- 6 within the department of business, economic development, and
- 7 tourism of one full-time equivalent (1.00 FTE) permanent
- 8 broadband coordinator position to create a state broadband plan.
- 9 SECTION 2. (a) There is established within the department
- 10 of business, economic development, and tourism one full-time
- 11 equivalent (1.00 FTE) permanent broadband coordinator position,
- 12 which shall be exempt from chapter 76, Hawaii Revised Statutes,
- 13 and shall report directly to the director of business, economic
- 14 development, and tourism.
- 15 The broadband coordinator, with the assistance of the
- 16 department of business, economic development, and tourism, shall
- 17 create a state broadband plan, which shall be submitted along

- 1 with a report to the legislature no later than twenty days prior
- 2 to the convening of the regular session of 2018. The state
- 3 broadband plan shall include, at a minimum, a statewide
- 4 broadband infrastructure gap analysis, identification of
- 5 opportunities to encourage private sector deployment of
- 6 ubiquitous high speed broadband, and an analysis of how
- 7 government stakeholders can better coordinate efforts.
- 8 Further, the broadband coordinator shall consider for
- 9 inclusion in the state broadband plan:
- (1) An analysis of current broadband infrastructure and
 geographic broadband gaps;
- 12 (2) An inventory of current community broadband resources;
- 13 (3) Recommendations on improving digital literacy,
- including the development and use of school-based
- programs;

- current and future broadband resources and needs;
