A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH CARE COORDINATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. There is appropriated out of the general
2	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$1,500,000 or so much
3	thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2017-2018 and the
4	same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
5	2018-2019 for the public-private partnership established by
6	section 323F-12, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to research, develop,
7	and implement a model of health care delivery in Maui county
8	that addresses coordination of care in a manner that is
9	seamless, efficient, appropriate, and cost-effective.
10	The sums appropriated shall be expended by the Hawaii
11	health systems corporation for the purposes of this Act.

SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2017.
