BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 291C-104, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 3 "(c) Any person who violates this section shall be fined
- 4 [\$250,] \$750, may be charged with a surcharge of up to \$100 to
- 5 be deposited into the trauma system special fund, and, where the
- 6 violation involves speeding in a school zone, shall be charged
- 7 with a surcharge of \$25 to be deposited into the safe routes to
- 8 school program special fund."
- 9 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 10 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 11 begun before its effective date.
- 12 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 13 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 14 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
