A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SEPARATION BENEFITS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. There is appropriated out of the general
- 2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$30,000,000 or so
- 3 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2017-2018 and
- 4 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
- 5 year 2018-2019 for severance benefits for separated employees
- 6 affected by Act 103, Session Laws of Hawaii 2015, as may be
- 7 negotiated through collective bargaining supplemental
- 8 agreements.
- 9 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the Hawaii
- 10 health systems corporation for the purposes of this Act.
- 11 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect on January 7, 2059.
