A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. The purpose of this Act is to add elements
2.	concernin	g sexual abuse and sexual assault to Hawaii's existing
3	sexuality	health education law. The teaching of this portion of
4	the sexua	lity health education curriculum is to be permissive
5	and may i	nclude general information and education on:
6	(1)	Methods of preventing sexual abuse and sexual assault;
7	(2)	Identification of the signs of sexual abuse and sexual
8		assault;
9	(3)	Available safety resources for victims of sexual abuse
10		and sexual assault; and
11	(4)	Available health resources for victims of sexual abuse
12		and sexual assault.
13	SECT	ION 2. Section 321-11.1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
14	amended t	o read as follows:
15	"[+]	§321-11.1[+] Medically accurate sexuality health
16	education	. (a) Sexuality health education programs funded by

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1	the State	shall provide medically accurate and factual
2	information	on that [is]:
3	(1)	<u>Is</u> age appropriate [and includes];
4	(2)	<u>Includes</u> education on abstinence, contraception, and
5		methods of disease prevention to prevent unintended
6		pregnancy and sexually transmitted disease, including
7		human immunodeficiency virus [-]; and
8	(3)	May include education on sexual abuse and sexual
9		assault, methods of preventing sexual abuse and sexual
10		assault, identification of the signs of sexual abuse
11		and sexual assault, available safety resources for
12		victims of sexual abuse and sexual assault, and
13		available health resources for victims of sexual abuse
14		and sexual assault.
15	(b)	For the purposes of this section:
16	"Age	appropriate" means suitable to a particular age or age
17	group bas	ed on developing cognitive, emotional, and behavioral
18	capacity	typical for that age or age group.
19	"Fac	tual information" means medical, psychiatric,
20	psychological, empirical, or statistical information that is	
21	verified	or supported by research conducted by recognized

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- 1 medical, psychiatric, psychological, and public health
- 2 professionals or organizations.
- 3 "Medically accurate" means verified or supported by
- 4 research conducted in compliance with accepted scientific
- 5 methods and recognized as accurate and objective by professional
- 6 organizations and agencies with expertise in the relevant field,
- 7 such as the federal Centers for Disease Control and Prevention,
- 8 the American Public Health Association, the American Academy of
- 9 Pediatrics, and the American College of Obstetricians and
- 10 Gynecologists.
- 11 "Sexuality health education" means education in any medium
- 12 regarding human development and sexuality, including education
- 13 on pregnancy, family planning, [and] sexually transmitted
- 14 diseases [-], and sexual abuse and sexual assault."
- 15 SECTION 3. The board of education shall submit a report of
- 16 its findings and recommendations on the inclusion of education
- 17 on sexual abuse and sexual assault in the sexuality health
- 18 education curriculum, including any proposed legislation, to the
- 19 legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of
- 20 the regular session of 2019.

- 1 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 2 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 3 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.

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Report Title:

Sexual Abuse; Sexual Assault; Comprehensive Sex Education

Description:

Authorizes the inclusion of education about sexual abuse and sexual assault, including prevention, identification, safety resources, and health resources for victims. Requires the Board of Education to report to the Legislature prior to the regular session of 2019. (HB856 HD1)

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
