## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HISTORIC PRESERVATION.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that section 6E-42,
- 2 Hawaii Revised Statutes, plays an essential role in the
- 3 protection and management of the State's historic places, burial
- 4 sites, and aviation artifacts. Section 6E-42 requires agencies
- 5 and officers of the State and its subdivisions to submit for
- 6 review all projects that may affect historic properties to the
- 7 state historic preservation division in the department of land
- 8 and natural resources prior to approval.
- 9 Due to the current strength of the State's economy, demand
- 10 for housing, and critical infrastructure needs, the state
- 11 historic preservation division has an unacceptable backlog of
- 12 projects needing review. The state historic preservation
- 13 division has also experienced problems recruiting technical
- 14 professionals due to the highly competitive nature of the job
- 15 market, which is exacerbated by the limited size of the pool of
- 16 qualified applicants. In order to increase the size of the pool
- 17 of qualified applicants and assist in reducing the state

- 2 legislature believes it is necessary to add student intern

- 4 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds to support
- 5 five student intern positions within the state historic

- 7 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 8 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 9 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2017-2018 and
- 10 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
- 11 year 2018-2019 for five full-time equivalent (5.00 FTE)
- 12 temporary student intern II positions within the state historic
- 13 preservation division.
- 14 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the state
- 15 historic preservation division for the purposes of this Act.
- 16 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
