# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PESTICIDES.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that there are nearly ten
- 2 thousand pesticides registered for use in Hawaii. The
- 3 department of agriculture is responsible for ensuring pesticides
- 4 are used correctly in Hawaii. The legislature further finds
- 5 that it is in the interest of the public to enhance the ability
- 6 of the department of agriculture and the University of Hawaii
- 7 college of tropical agriculture and human resources to respond
- 8 to questions about pesticide use and make recommendations
- 9 regarding pesticides for the protection of public safety and the
- 10 environment. The legislature concludes that this can best be
- 11 accomplished by increasing the amount of funds available to the
- 12 department of agriculture.
- 13 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to increase the cap
- 14 on the pesticide use revolving fund.
- 15 SECTION 2. Section 149A-13.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 16 amended by amending subsection (e) to read as follows:

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- 1 "(e) All unobligated, unencumbered, or unexpended funds
- 2 remaining in the fund in excess of [\$250,000] \$1,000,000 at the
- 3 close of each fiscal year shall lapse to the state general
- 4 fund."
- 5 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 6 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 7 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
