## A BILL FOR AN ACT

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 431:10C-103.6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, 1 is amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows: 2 "(c) Acupuncture treatments shall be allowed for no more 3 than thirty visits at no more than [\$75] \$ a visit[-]; 4 5 provided that this dollar amount shall increase by per cent and be rounded up to the nearest dollar on July 1, 2018, and 6 subsequently increase in the same manner on July 1 of every year 7 thereafter." 8 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 9 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. 10 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2017. 11 12
