
HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE AUDITOR TO CONDUCT A REVIEW AND MANAGEMENT AUDIT
OF THE DEPARTMENT OF LAND AND NATURAL RESOURCES' MANAGEMENT
OF AND ENFORCEMENT EFFORTS AT KAA NAPALI BEACH.

1 WHEREAS, section 13-251-76, Hawaii Administrative Rules,
2 prohibits any person from engaging in commercial activity in or
3 on Kaanapali ocean waters and beach without a written permit or
4 registration certificate from the Board of Land and Natural
5 Resources or the Board's authorized representatives; and
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7 WHEREAS, the Department of Land and Natural Resources is
8 responsible for enforcing section 13-251-76, Hawaii
9 Administrative Rules, and other laws and rules relating the use
10 of Kaanapali Beach; and
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12 WHEREAS, concerns have been expressed about unauthorized
13 commercial activities taking place at Kaanapali Beach; and
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15 WHEREAS, there may be a lack of adequate funding for the
16 Department of Land and Natural Resources to effectively enforce
17 laws and rules regarding commercial activities at Kaanapali
18 Beach; now, therefore,
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20 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
21 Twenty-ninth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session
22 of 2018, the Senate concurring, that the Auditor is requested to
23 conduct a review and management audit of management and
24 enforcement efforts by the Department of Land and Natural
25 Resources regarding Kaanapali Beach; and
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27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Auditor is requested to
28 report the Auditor's findings and recommendations to the
29 Legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of
30 the Regular Session of 2019; and



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2 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
3 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Auditor; the
4 Chairperson of the Board of Land and Natural Resources; and the
5 Administrator of the Division of Boating and Ocean Recreation
6 and the Enforcement Chief of the Division of Conservation and
7 Resources Enforcement, Department of Land and Natural Resources.
