
HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING AN INCREASED HONOLULU POLICE DEPARTMENT PRESENCE IN
THE CHINATOWN AND DOWNTOWN HONOLULU AREAS.

1 WHEREAS, the Chinatown Historic District in Honolulu is one
2 of the oldest Chinatowns in the United States, and Downtown
3 Honolulu is home to some of Oahu's most historic places; and
4

5 WHEREAS, it is important to maintain the safety of business
6 owners, workers, and patrons, as well as to protect their
7 property and possessions; encourage commercial activity; and
8 preserve the history and culture of the Chinatown and Downtown
9 Honolulu areas; and
10

11 WHEREAS, crimes such as drug dealing, illegal gambling,
12 robbery, and purse snatching are plaguing business owners and
13 dissuading visitors from visiting these areas; and
14

15 WHEREAS, there has been an increase in crime, particularly
16 in assaults and thefts, during the last quarter of 2016; and
17

18 WHEREAS, in September 2016, a woman was fatally shot in an
19 illegal gaming room in the Chinatown area, and in September
20 2017, a man was fatally shot while he sat outside a Chinatown
21 store; and
22

23 WHEREAS, according to a Honolulu Police Department (HPD)
24 report, there was a total of fifty-three reported incidents
25 relating to motor vehicle theft, theft, unauthorized entry into
26 a motor vehicle, or graffiti-related incidents from January 6,
27 2018, through January 19, 2018, in Sector 1, identified as the
28 Downtown, Aala Park, and Chinatown area; and

1 WHEREAS, while the number of reported incidents within a
 2 short period of time is already a concern, many crimes may not
 3 be reported to HPD; and

4
 5 WHEREAS, there is concern about the recent increase in and
 6 severity of criminal activity, and business owners in Chinatown
 7 are calling for more police presence in the area; and

8
 9 WHEREAS, increasing the visible presence of uniformed
 10 police officers would improve public safety by deterring
 11 criminal activity as well as providing more immediate assistance
 12 to victims once a crime has been committed; now, therefore,

13
 14 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
 15 Twenty-ninth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session
 16 of 2018, the Senate concurring, that the Mayor of the City and
 17 County of Honolulu and the Honolulu City Council are strongly
 18 urged to allocate more resources to the Honolulu Police
 19 Department, for the purpose of increasing visible police
 20 presence in, and active patrols of, the Downtown and Chinatown
 21 areas; and

 23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
 24 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Mayor of the City
 25 and County of Honolulu, the Chair of the Honolulu City Council,
 26 the Chief of the Honolulu Police Department, and the Chair of
 27 the Downtown-Chinatown Neighborhood Board.
