
HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

ENCOURAGING THE DEPARTMENT OF LAND AND NATURAL RESOURCES AND
DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION OF THE CITY AND COUNTY
OF HONOLULU TO COLLABORATIVELY WORK WITH COMMUNITY
STAKEHOLDERS TO IDENTIFY AND ESTABLISH OFF-LEASH DOG PARKS
ON THE WINDWARD SIDE OF OAHU.

1 WHEREAS, according to the American Veterinary Medical
2 Association, the national average for households owning at least
3 one dog is 36.5 percent; however, pet ownership on Oahu is much
4 higher, with at least 60 percent of households owning at least
5 one dog or cat; and

7 WHEREAS, off-leash parks are good for dogs, their owners,
8 and the whole community, as these parks provide opportunities
9 for physical and mental exercise, as well as opportunities to
10 develop and maintain social skills, for dogs and their owners;

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13 WHEREAS, there are limited places to take dogs on the
14 Windward side of Oahu, where there are six parks where only
15 leashed dogs are allowed; and
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17 WHEREAS, there are only five off-leash dog parks on the
18 island of Oahu, none of which are on the Windward side of the
19 island; and
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21 WHEREAS, the Windward Dog Park Hui has been actively
22 searching for suitable places to establish off-leash dog parks
23 in their community; and
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25 WHEREAS, off-leash dog parks, whether privately or publicly
26 owned, are maintained by volunteers and require users to pick up
27 after their dogs so that all park users can enjoy a clean and
28 safe environment; now, therefore,

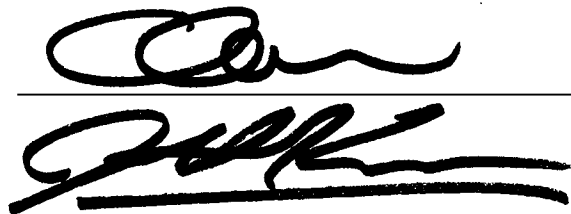

1 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
