## HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

---

REQUESTING THAT THE HAWAII COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY  
RETAIN THE KAKAAKO RESERVED HOUSING RULES IN THEIR CURRENT,  
UNAMENDED FORM.

1 WHEREAS, on November 11, 2011, chapter 15-218, Hawaii  
2 Administrative Rules, entitled "Kakaako Reserved Housing Rules",  
3 became effective, replacing chapter 15-22, Hawaii Administrative  
4 Rules, "The Mauka Area Rules" of the Hawaii Community  
5 Development Authority; and  
6

7 WHEREAS, pursuant to section 15-218-1, Hawaii  
8 Administrative Rules, the purpose and intent of the Kakaako  
9 Reserved Housing Rules "is to establish an increased supply of  
10 housing for residents of low- or moderate-income within the  
11 Kakaako community development district"; and  
12

13 WHEREAS, section 15-218-17, Hawaii Administrative Rules,  
14 requires that certain new developments or redevelopments within  
15 the Kakaako community development district designate at least  
16 twenty percent of the total residential floor area as reserved  
17 housing units, or designate fifteen percent of the total  
18 residential floor area as reserved housing units if the units of  
19 a new development or redevelopment are developed as rental  
20 units; and

22 WHEREAS, the Kakaako Reserved Housing Rules are  
23 administered by the Hawaii Community Development Authority,  
24 which now seeks to amend the rules; and

26 WHEREAS, the Legislature objects to the proposed rule  
27 amendments; now, therefore,

29 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the  
30 Twenty-ninth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session


