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# HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

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REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE AND CONSUMER AFFAIRS TO  
CONVENE A WORKING GROUP TO EVALUATE THE REGULATION OF  
PEER-TO-PEER CAR SHARING AND TO CONSIDER STANDARDS OF  
PRACTICE FOR THIS INDUSTRY.

1 WHEREAS, a new mode of transportation has recently  
2 developed where private individuals are now sharing their  
3 personal vehicles with other individuals via third-party web-  
4 based platforms; and

6 WHEREAS, in the State of Hawaii, there are anywhere up to  
7 150 personal vehicles available to share via third-party web-  
8 based platforms ranging from \$30 to \$550 per day; and

9  
10 WHEREAS, peer-to-peer car sharing on a fee basis via  
11 third-party web-based platforms is currently unregulated and  
12 as a result, there are no regulations in place to ensure that  
13 vehicle safety standards are met, that vehicles are being  
14 rented to qualified individuals, and that the vehicles have  
15 adequate insurance coverage; now, therefore,

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17 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the  
18 Twenty-ninth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session  
19 of 2018, the Senate concurring, that the Department of Commerce  
20 and Consumer Affairs is requested to convene a working group  
21 to evaluate the regulation of peer-to-peer car sharing and to  
22 consider standards of practice for this emerging industry to  
23 ensure the safety of the public; and

25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the working group is requested  
26 to research and review safety and maintenance standards,  
27 liability and insurance limits, airport and public access, and  
28 pricing, fees, and taxes as they pertain to peer-to-peer car  
29 sharing; and



1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of Commerce and  
2 Consumer Affairs or the Director's designee is requested to  
3 serve as the Chair of the working group and to invite  
4 participation by one representative from each of the  
5 following:

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- 7 (1) The Department of Transportation;
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- 9 (2) The Insurance Division of the Department of Commerce  
10 and Consumer Affairs;
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- 12 (3) The Division of Consumer Advocacy of the Department  
13 of Commerce and Consumer Affairs;
- 14
- 15 (4) Two motor vehicle rental companies with a presence  
16 in the State of Hawaii;
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- 18 (5) Two licensed automobile insurers conducting business  
19 in the State of Hawaii; and
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- 21 (6) Two peer-to-peer car sharing companies; and
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23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this  
24 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Director of Commerce  
25 and Consumer Affairs, Director of Transportation, Insurance  
26 Commissioner, and Consumer Advocate.
