HOUSE RESOLUTION

URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO ASSESS THE DANGERS OF PEDESTRIAN USE OF THE SHOULDER OF HALEAKALA HIGHWAY BETWEEN UPPER KIMO DRIVE AND AINAKULA ROAD AND TO EXAMINE POTENTIAL PEDESTRIAN SAFETY COUNTERMEASURES.

1 WHEREAS, the population of the Kula district of Maui has 2 grown by roughly sixteen percent since 2010, with the number of pedestrians growing along with the population; and 3 4 WHEREAS, the portion of Haleakala Highway between Upper 5 6 Kimo Drive and Ainakula Road and adjacent to Kula Lodge and Kula 7 Marketplace, is heavily trafficked by both motorists and pedestrians; and 8 9 WHEREAS, cars frequently exceed the speed limit of thirty 10 miles per hour in this area; and 11 12 WHEREAS, due to the lack of an official sidewalk or 13 pedestrian walkway in the area, pedestrians often use the six 14 inch-wide shoulder of Haleakala Highway as a walkway; and 15 16 WHEREAS, pedestrian use of this narrow shoulder poses a 17 danger to both pedestrians and motorists; now, therefore, 18 19 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 20 Twenty-ninth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session 21 of 2018, that the Highways Division of the Department of 22 Transportation is requested to: 23 24 Assess the dangers of pedestrian use of the shoulder 25 (1)on the portion of Haleakala Highway between Upper Kimo 26 Drive and Ainakula Road; 27 28 Examine the effectiveness of potential pedestrian (2) 29 safety countermeasures; and 30 31
