1		EAS, Americans prefer local newspapers as their main	
2	source of local news, according to a 2017 survey from the

6	local topics including community events, crime, taxes, local		
7	government, arts and culture, social services, zoning and		
8	development, and are tied for the top source on housing,		
9	schools, jobs, and local political news, according to a survey		
10	conducted by the Pew Research Center, in conjunction with the		
11	Knight Foundation; and

13	WHEREAS, further, newspapers fulfill an important function		
14	by publishing announcements of individuals' passings; and

16	WHERE	EAS, these announcements:	
17	(1)	Inform relatives, acquaintances, friends, coworkers,

30	WHEREAS, the Honolulu Star-Advertiser is the only newspaper		
31	on Oahu, online and in print, that publishes these important

	(1) Death Notices, which are free, basic announcements limited to the deceased individual's name, age, gender, area of residence, date of passing, and information regarding any services; and			
9 10 11 12 13	(2) Family Placed Obituaries and Featured, which are announcements that are paid per column inch per day and may include more details about the deceased individual, such as kinship listings; and			
14 15 16	WHEREAS, Hawaii's "Ohana" society is based upon the close relationships individuals form with family, coworkers, classmates, and others; and			
17 18 19 20 21	WHEREAS, the kinship listing allows readers to recognize those in their community that will be entering bereavement and verify whether they know the deceased individual; now, therefore,			
22 23 24 25 26	BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Twenty-ninth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Sess of 2018, that the Honolulu Star-Advertiser is urged to include immediate next-of-kin information within free death notices; a			
27 28 29 30 31	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that funeral homes in Hawaii are urged to assist in gathering next-of-kin information to be included in free death notices when the funeral home communicates with family members of the deceased; and
