## HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING AN INCREASED HONOLULU POLICE PRESENCE IN WAI'ANAЕ.

1           WHEREAS, Wai'anae is one of the most historic and culturally  
2 rich areas of O'ahu; and

3  
4           WHEREAS, it is important to maintain the safety of Wai'anae  
5 residents, business owners, workers, and patrons, as well as to  
6 protect their property and possessions; and

7  
8           WHEREAS, during the first month of 2018, crimes such as  
9 homicide, unauthorized entry into a motor vehicle, and weapons  
10 possession were the highest in Wai'anae than in any other  
11 district on O'ahu; and

12  
13           WHEREAS, there was a high number of reported crimes,  
14 particularly in assaults and thefts, during the last quarter of  
15 2017 in Wai'anae; and

16  
17           WHEREAS, according to a Honolulu Police Department (HPD)  
18 report, there was a total of two homicides, forty-one reported  
19 incidents relating to assault, forty-one reported burglaries,  
20 twenty-eight reported drug crimes, seventy reports of property  
21 damage, five reported sexual assaults, one hundred and seventy-  
22 two reports of thefts, fifteen reports of threatening, one  
23 hundred and forty-three reports of unauthorized entry into a  
24 motor vehicle, and six weapons incidents during January of 2018,  
25 in District 8, which includes West Oahu; and

27           WHEREAS, while the number of reported incidents within a  
28 short period of time is already a concern, many crimes may not  
29 be reported to HPD; and

31           WHEREAS, there is concern about the recent increase in and  
32 severity of criminal activity, and local residents and business

1 owners in Wai'anae are calling for more police presence in the  
2 area; and  
3

4 WHEREAS, increasing the visible presence of uniformed  
5 police officers would improve public safety by deterring  
6 criminal activity as well as providing more immediate assistance  
7 to victims once a crime has been committed; now, therefore,  
8

9 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the  
10 Twenty-ninth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session  
11 of 2018, that the Mayor of the City and County of Honolulu and  
12 the Honolulu City Council are strongly urged to allocate more  
13 resources to the Honolulu Police Department, for the purpose of  
14 increasing visible police presence in, and active patrols of,  
15 Wai'anae; and

17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this  
18 Resolution be transmitted to the Mayor of the City and County of  
19 Honolulu, the Chair of the Honolulu City Council, the Chief of  
20 the Honolulu Police Department, and the Chair of the Wai'anae  
21 Neighborhood Board.
