HOUSE RESOLUTION

ENDORSING TAIWAN'S PARTICIPATION AS AN OBSERVER IN THE UNITED NATIONS FRAMEWORK CONVENTION ON CLIMATE CHANGE, INTERNATIONAL CIVIL AVIATION ORGANIZATION, WORLD HEALTH ORGANIZATION, AND INTERNATIONAL CRIMINAL POLICE ORGANIZATION; ENCOURAGING A U.S.-TAIWAN BILATERAL TRADE AGREEMENT; AND CELEBRATING THE STATE OF HAWAII'S TWENTY-FIFTH ANNIVERSARY OF SISTER-STATE RELATIONS WITH TAIWAN.

WHEREAS, as a global citizen, Taiwan upholds the universal 1 2 values of peace, freedom, democracy, and human rights; and 3 4 WHEREAS, Taiwan is a committed provider of humanitarian 5 aid; from malaria prevention programs in Africa, to agricultural projects in Latin America and the Caribbean; from medical 6 missions in the South Pacific, to disaster relief in Asia; these 7 are a few examples of how Taiwan has consistently strived to 8 9 make a real difference throughout the world; and 10 WHEREAS, for years, Taiwan has actively engaged in climate 11 change research, supported anti-terrorism cooperation, and 12 13 worked with its partners to tackle transnational crime; and 14 WHEREAS, through its participation in its annual World 15 Health Assembly since April of 2009, Taiwan has shared its 16 17 renowned expertise in disease control and prevention; and 18 19 WHEREAS, Taiwan's meaningful participation in international bodies such as the World Health Organization, International 20 Criminal Police Organization, United Nations Framework 21 Convention on Climate Change, and International Civil Aviation 22 Organization would make international mechanisms truly global; 23 and 24 25 WHEREAS, Hawaii has a strong cultural, historical, and 26 economic relationship with Taiwan since sister-state relations 27 28 were established on December 19, 1993, and the bonds of true friendship and a steadfast trade partnership have strengthened 29 over the past twenty-five years; and 30 31

1 WHEREAS, Taiwan is the tenth largest trading partner of the United States with more than \$65,000,000,000 in goods traded 2 between the United States and Taiwan in 2016, and the United 3 States is the leading country for foreign direct investment in 4 5 Taiwan; and 6 7 WHEREAS, the deep economic relationship between the United States and Taiwan has created hundreds of thousands of jobs in 8 9 the United States that rely on exports to Taiwan; now, 10 therefore, 11 12 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Twenty-ninth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session 13 14 of 2018, that this body joins the United States in endorsing the participation of Taiwan as an observer in the United Nations 15 16 Framework Convention on Climate Change, International Civil Aviation Organization, World Health Organization, and 17 18 International Criminal Police Organization; and 19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this body also joins the United 20 States House of Representatives in encouraging the United States 21 22 Trade Representative to commence negotiations to enter into a bilateral trade agreement with Taiwan; and 23 24 25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this body supports the State of Hawaii's twenty-fifth anniversary of sister-state relations with 26 27 Taiwan; and 28 29 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Resolution be transmitted to the President of the United States; 30 President Pro Tempore of the United States Senate; Speaker of 31 the United States House of Representatives; United States 32 33 Secretary of State; members of Hawaii's congressional delegation; Governor; and Director of Business, Economic 34 Development, and Tourism. 35 36 37 38 FFERED BY:
