## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that campus planning
- 2 requires a long-term view that ultimately guides the day-to-day
- 3 business decisions and investments of a university. A campus
- 4 master plan mirrors academic vision and guides the creation of a
- 5 physical learning environment with lasting values. The master
- 6 plan should integrate academic planning and strategic goals with
- 7 facilities, infrastructure, and financial resources.
- 8 The legislature further finds that the University of Hawaii
- 9 has not updated its long range development plan since 2007.
- 10 This plan serves as a guiding document for campus development.
- 11 Updating the long range development plan serves to reflect
- 12 current and upcoming educational priorities developed through
- 13 consultation with the office of physical, environmental, and
- 14 long range planning, as well as with students, faculty, staff,
- 15 and community representatives.

# S.B. NO. 5.D. 2

Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to require the 1 University of Hawaii system to develop a campus master plan that 2 3 includes academic and facilities plans for each campus. 4 SECTION 2. (a) The University of Hawaii system shall create a campus master plan that addresses the needs of each 5 campus within the university system. The campus master plan 6 7 shall incorporate academic and facilities plans for each campus 8 and include five- and ten-year timelines. The campus master 9 plan shall strive to accomplish the following: 10 (1) Accommodate growth; 11 Revitalize the core campus; (2) Enhance the central campus; 12 (3) **13** Forge strategic partnerships; (4)Facilitate safer and more efficient mobility; 14 (5) Transform corridors and pedestrian paths; 15 (6) Improve learning and research environments; 16 (7) Integrate academic and residential life; and **17** (8) Provide sufficient flexibility to accommodate ongoing 18 (9) change that is expected in a dynamic higher education 19 learning environment during the next ten to twenty 20 21 years.

- 3 (1) Facilities should be responsive to programs and the
  4 manner in which programs are delivered;
- (2) The physical environment should contribute
   aesthetically and physically to the overall education
   experience; and
- 8 (3) Optimal use should be made of existing facilities
   9 through renovation, conversion, and remodeling when
   10 possible.
- 11 (c) The campus master plan shall acknowledge the need for 12 future studies that will enable the university to accomplish the 13 following goals: creating an academic plan, landscape plan, 14 student and residential life plan, and athletics plan; as well 15 as engaging greater county and state cooperation.
- 16 (d) The University of Hawaii system shall collaborate with
  17 the school of architecture to create the campus master plan.
- (e) No later than twenty days prior to the convening of
  the regular session of 2018, the University of Hawaii system
  shall submit a report to the legislature on the status of
  creating the campus master plan.

- 1 (f) The University of Hawaii system shall submit the
- 2 campus master plan to the legislature no later than sixty days
- 3 prior to the convening of the regular session of 2019.
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on May 12, 2059.

### Report Title:

University of Hawaii System; Campus Master Plan
