A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE STATE OF GOA, REPUBLIC OF INDIA.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature established a sister-state
2 relationship between the State of Hawaii and the State of Goa,
3 Republic of India through the adoption of Senate Concurrent
4 Resolution No. 20, S.D. 1, H.D. 1 (2016).

5 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds to the
6 department of business, economic development, and tourism for
7 the establishment of a State of Hawaii sister-state office in
8 the State of Goa, Republic of India.

9 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
10 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$250,000 or so much
11 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2017-2018 and the
12 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
13 2018-2019 for the department of business, economic development,
14 and tourism to establish a State of Hawaii sister-state office
15 in the State of Goa, Republic of India.





1 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
2 of business, economic development, and tourism for the purposes
3 of this Act.

4 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2017.
