1 The enacting clause of each law shall be, "Be it enacted by the
2 legislature of the State of Hawaii."

3 SECTION 3. The question to be printed on the ballot shall
4 be as follows:

5 "Shall a bill be prohibited from becoming law if it has
6 been so altered or amended during its passage through
7 either house that the bill no longer reflects its original
8 purpose, unless the bill is approved by a two-thirds vote
9 in both the house and senate?"

10 SECTION 4. New constitutional material is underscored.

11 SECTION 5. This amendment shall take effect upon
12 compliance with article XVII, section 3, of the Constitution of
13 the State of Hawaii.

Amends Article III, section 14, of the Hawaii Constitution, to ensure that no bill becomes law if the legislature has so altered or amended the bill during its passage through either house that it no longer reflects its original purpose, unless the bill is approved by a two-thirds vote in both the house and senate.
