RELATING TO HEALTH.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 432E, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 3 and to read as follows:
- 4 "\$432E- Effective communication; penalty. Any health
- 5 care provider who fails to provide auxiliary aids and services,
- 6 including qualified sign language interpreters, in order to
- 7 achieve effective communication with an enrollee who has a
- 8 communication disability, such as a vision, speech, or hearing
- 9 disability, shall be assessed a fine by the commissioner equal
- 10 to three times the cost of providing a qualified auxiliary aid
- 11 or service for the length of the enrollee's interaction with the
- 12 provider."
- 13 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 14 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 15 begun before its effective date.
- 16 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
