
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. (a) The auditor shall conduct an audit of each
2 contract between the department of health and domestic violence
3 nonprofit organizations and the department of human services and
4 domestic violence nonprofit organizations entered into in the
5 past years. The audits shall focus on accountability and
6 oversight of the state funding expended pursuant to each
7 contract including:

8 (1) The percentage of total expenditures under each
9 contract allocated for staff and administrative costs
10 compared to the costs of providing services directly
11 for domestic violence victims;

12 (2) Recommendations on department contracting practices to
13 improve comprehensive care for domestic violence
14 victims; and



1 (3) Recommendations on best contracting practices to
2 increase efficiency by reducing staff and
3 administrative expenditures so that more funds may be
4 expended for the direct benefit of domestic violence victims.

5 (b) The office of the auditor shall submit a report of its
6 findings and recommendations, including any proposed
7 legislation, to the legislature no later than twenty days prior
8 to the convening of the regular session of 2019.

9 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.
