
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that a cardiac care unit
2 is needed in Hawaii county as the county's residents suffering
3 from heart problems or strokes are often airlifted to Oahu or
4 Maui to receive critical medical care. An individual suffering
5 from cardiac complications must receive interventional care
6 within two hours in order to recover completely. An evaluation
7 and airlift to Oahu or Maui, however, can take much more than
8 two hours, increasing the risk that the patient may not fully
9 recover.

10 The legislature further finds that while there are barriers
11 to offering interventional cardiology for heart attack treatment
12 to Hawaii county residents, Hilo medical center has reduced many
13 of these barriers. This has been done through the acquisition
14 and installation of cardiac imaging equipment and software, as
15 well as establishing cardiology clinic infrastructure designed
16 for up to three cardiologists and supporting providers. Because
17 cardiac interventions are complicated procedures, it is



1 important that Hilo medical center receives support in order to
2 expand its offering of interventional cardiology for heart
3 attack treatment, and thereby continue to save lives and improve
4 the quality of life for cardiac patients.

5 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds to the
6 Hawaii health systems corporation to improve the health care
7 services related to cardiac care at Hilo medical center.

8 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
9 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
10 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2018-2019 to the
11 Hawaii health systems corporation to improve the health care
12 services at Hilo medical center; provided that the funds shall
13 be used for the following:

- 14 (1) Costs associated with recruiting and employing two
15 additional cardiologists while they establish their
16 invasive cardiology practice;
- 17 (2) Costs of support staff required to support the
18 cardiology practice;
- 19 (3) Initial training of catheterization lab, intensive
20 care unit, and radiology staff;



- 1 (4) Purchasing of inventory of medical devices and
- 2 medications used for interventional cardiology
- 3 procedures;
- 4 (5) Purchasing of medical equipment for the cardiac
- 5 catheterization lab and intensive care unit;
- 6 (6) Purchasing of diagnostic laboratory equipment; and
- 7 (7) Initial costs of a certified lab technician.

8 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the Hawaii health
9 systems corporation for the purposes of this Act.

10 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
