A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MOPEDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 291C-206, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended to read as follows: 2 3 "§291C-206 Modifying moped motor; removing speed limiter; (a) A [motor used to power a] moped shall not be 4 violation. 5 modified in any manner by the owner of the moped or by a moped 6 dealer or repair shop, including modifying a motor used to power a moped or removing a speed limiter to increase the top speed 7 8 and horsepower, except as authorized by the motor manufacturer, 9 and any such modification shall not increase the power capacity 10 of the motor above two horsepower (one thousand four hundred 11 ninety-two watts). For purposes of this section, "speed limiter" means a device used to limit the top speed of a vehicle.

- 14 [(b)] (c) Any [person] owner who violates this section
- 15 shall be fined not more than \$500. Violation of this section by
- 16 a moped dealer or repair shop shall constitute a petty
- 17 misdemeanor punishable by a fine under section 706-640(1)(e);

- 3 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 4 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 5 begun before its effective date.
- 6 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 7 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 8 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

Mopeds; Modification; Speed Limiter; Penalty

Description:

Prohibits the owner of a moped or a moped dealer or repair shop from modifying a moped, including removing a speed limiter, to increase the top speed and horsepower. Makes current fine applicable to moped owners. Increases penalty to a petty misdemeanor fine for a moped dealer or repair shop. Clarifies a moped dealer or repair shop will not be fined unless the dealer or shop is the entity that makes the modification. (SD1)
