A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO NATIVE HAWAIIANS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	PART I
2	SECTION 1. The legislature finds that article X, section
3	4, of the Hawai'i State Constitution provides, in pertinent part
4	"The State shall promote the study of Hawaiian culture, history
5	and language". In addition, article XV, section 4, of the
6	Hawai'i State Constitution establishes Hawaiian as one of two
7	official languages of the State of Hawaiʻi.
8	The purpose of this part is to appropriate funds to the
9	University of Hawai'i to translate the Hawai'i State Constitution
10	into the Hawaiian language.
11	SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
12	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
13	much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2018-2019 to
14	translate the Hawai'i State Constitution into the Hawaiian
15	language.

- The sum appropriated shall be expended by the University of 1 2 Hawai'i for the purposes of this part. 3 PART II 4 SECTION 3. Chapter 601, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 5 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated 6 and to read as follows: 7 Hawaiian language; interpreter services. "§601-8 Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, a court, to the 9 extent reasonably possible, shall provide interpreter services 10 if any party to a proceeding requests that the proceeding be 11 conducted in the Hawaiian language." 12 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general 13 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so 14 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2018-2019 to 15 establish one full-time equivalent (1.0 FTE) position for the **16** judiciary to provide interpreter services in the Hawaiian 17 language in accordance with this part. The position shall be 18 exempt from the requirements of chapter 76, Hawaii Revised 19 Statutes. 20 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the judiciary for
