A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SMOKING ON SIDEWALKS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 328J, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 3 and to read as follows:
- 4 "§328J- Prohibition on sidewalks. Smoking shall be
- 5 prohibited on all sidewalks, as defined in section 291C-1."
- 6 SECTION 2. Section 328J-12, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 7 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
- 8 "(a) A person who smokes in an area or on a sidewalk where
- 9 smoking is prohibited by this chapter shall be guilty of a
- 10 violation and fined not more than \$50 to be deposited into the
- 11 general fund. The district courts may assess costs not to
- 12 exceed \$25 for issuing a penal summons upon any person who fails
- 13 to appear at the place within the time specified in the citation
- 14 issued to the person."
- 15 SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 16 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 17 begun before its effective date.
