RELATING TO HOMELESS YOUTH.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 2 highest per capita rate of homelessness of any state in the
- 3 nation. Hawaii also has the highest rate of chronic unsheltered
- 4 homeless per capita of any state. Currently, there are an
- 5 estimated 7,220 sheltered and unsheltered homeless people in
- 6 Hawaii, and youth service providers report that the number of
- 7 homeless youth has been increasing each year. Addressing
- 8 homelessness requires a multi-faceted approach using
- 9 interventions targeted to the particular characteristics of the
- 10 population being served.
- 11 The legislature further finds that homeless youth find
- 12 themselves living on the streets for a variety of reasons,
- 13 including having homeless families, aging out of foster care,
- 14 and running away from bad home situations. According to a 2016
- 15 survey on homeless youth in Honolulu, more than forty per cent
- 16 were forced to leave home by their families. The survey also
- 17 noted that thirty-eight per cent of homeless youth were

- 1 physically abused and assaulted while living on the streets.
- 2 Other reports and surveys indicate that nine out of ten homeless
- 3 youth have slept outdoors at a park, beach, on a sidewalk, or in
- 4 a car, and thirty per cent of Hawaii's juvenile arrests are for
- 5 running away from home. The legislature recognizes that current
- 6 resources for outreach and shelter options are limited as
- 7 unaccompanied homeless youth tend to be an underserved and
- 8 neglected population.
- 9 The purpose of this Act is to provide funding to the
- 10 department of human services to increase outreach and provide
- 11 shelter and services to unaccompanied homeless youth.
- 12 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 13 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$500,000 or so much
- 14 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2018-2019 to provide
- 15 outreach to and shelter and services for unaccompanied homeless
- 16 youth.
- 17 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 18 human services for the purposes of this Act.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2018.
