## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 353C-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
amended to read as follows:

3 "[+] §353C-3[+] Deputy directors; appointment. (a) The 4 director shall appoint, without regard to chapter 76, [three] 5 two deputy directors to serve at the director's pleasure. 6 Unless otherwise assigned by the director, one deputy director shall oversee the correctional programs and facilities of the 7 8 department [, one deputy director shall oversee the law 9 enforcement programs of the department,] and one deputy director 10 shall oversee administration of the department. 11 In addition to the deputy directors pursuant to (b) 12 subsection (a), there shall be a deputy director to oversee the 13 law enforcement programs of the department ("deputy of law 14 enforcement"). The deputy of law enforcement shall be appointed 15 under or in the manner provided in section 6, article V, of the 16 state constitution."
