RELATING TO CONDOMINIUMS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTI	ON 1. Section 514B-71, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by	amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
3	"(a)	The commission shall establish a condominium
4	education	trust fund that the commission shall use for
5	educationa	l purposes. Educational purposes shall include
6	financing	or promoting:
7	(1)	Education and research in the field of condominium
8		management, condominium project registration, and real
9		estate, for the benefit of the public and those
10		required to be registered under this chapter;
11	(2)	The improvement and more efficient administration of
12		associations;
13	(3)	Expeditious and inexpensive procedures for resolving
14		association disputes; and
15	(4)	Support for mediation or binding arbitration of
16		condominium related disputes."

1	SECTION 2. Section 514B-72, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
3	"(a) Each project or association with more than five
4	units, including any project or association with more than five
5	units subject to chapter 514A, shall pay to the department of
6	commerce and consumer affairs:
7	(1) A condominium education trust fund fee within one year
8	after the recordation of the purchase of the first
9	unit or within thirty days of the association's first
0	meeting, and thereafter, on or before June 30 of every
1	odd-numbered year, as prescribed by rules adopted
2	pursuant to chapter 91; and
3	(2) Beginning with the July 1, 2015, biennium
4	registration, an additional annual condominium
5	education trust fund fee in an amount equal to the
6	product of \$1.50 times the number of condominium units
7	included in the registered project or association to
8	be dedicated to supporting mediation or binding
9	arbitration of condominium related disputes. The

additional condominium education trust fund fee shall

total \$3 per unit until the commission adopts rules

1	pursuant to chapter 91. On June 30 of every odd-
2	numbered year, any unexpended additional amounts paid
3	into the condominium education trust fund and
4	initially dedicated to supporting mediation or binding
5	arbitration of condominium related disputes, as
6	required by this paragraph, shall be used for
7	educational purposes as provided in section 514B-
8	71(a)(1), (2), and (3)."
9	SECTION 3. Act 187, Session Laws of Hawaii 2013, is
10	amended by amending section 5 to read as follows:
11	"SECTION 5. The department of commerce and consumer
12	affairs professional and vocational licensing division's budget
13	ceiling shall be amended to reflect the additional annual
14	condominium education trust fund fee required by section 514B-
15	72(a)(2), Hawaii Revised Statutes, and paid into the condominium
16	education trust fund, established by section 514B-71, Hawaii
17	Revised Statutes. On June 30 of every odd-numbered year, any
18	unexpended additional amounts paid into the condominium
19	education trust fund and initially dedicated to supporting
20	mediation or binding arbitration of condominium related
21	disputes, as required by section 514B-72(a)(2), Hawaii Revised
