A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FIREARMS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 134-8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending its title and subsections (a) and (b) to
- 3 read as follows:
- 4 "§134-8 Ownership, etc., of automatic firearms, silencers,
- 5 trigger modification devices, etc., prohibited; penalties. (a)
- 6 The manufacture, possession, sale, barter, trade, gift,
- 7 transfer, or acquisition of any of the following is prohibited:
- 8 assault pistols, except as provided by section 134-4(e);
- 9 automatic firearms; rifles with barrel lengths less than sixteen
- 10 inches; shotguns with barrel lengths less than eighteen inches;
- 11 cannons; mufflers, silencers, or devices for deadening or
- 12 muffling the sound of discharged firearms; hand grenades,
- 13 dynamite, blasting caps, bombs, or bombshells, or other
- 14 explosives; a trigger modification device, bump stock or bump
- 15 fire device, trigger crank, or any part, combination of parts,
- 16 component, device, attachment, or accessory that is designed or
- 17 functions to accelerate the rate of fire of a semiautomatic

- 1 firearm; or any type of ammunition or any projectile component
- 2 thereof coated with teflon or any other similar coating designed
- 3 primarily to enhance its capability to penetrate metal or pierce
- 4 protective armor; and any type of ammunition or any projectile
- 5 component thereof designed or intended to explode or segment
- 6 upon impact with its target.
- 7 (b) Any person who installs, removes, or alters a firearm
- 8 part with the intent to convert the firearm to an automatic
- 9 firearm, or to accelerate the rate of fire of a semiautomatic
- 10 firearm, shall be deemed to have manufactured an automatic
- 11 firearm in violation of subsection (a)."
- 12 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 13 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 14 begun before its effective date.
- 15 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 16 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
