RELATING TO CONSUMER PROTECTION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 481B-5.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending subsection (1) to read as follows:
- 3 "(1) Any return policies adopted by the merchant pursuant
- 4 to this section that limits the purchaser's ability to obtain a
- 5 refund shall not apply if the goods were damaged or defective
- 6 prior to the time of sale, unless the merchant was aware of the
- 7 damage or defect and notified the purchaser of the damage or
- 8 defect in writing prior to the time of sale. All refunds for
- 9 goods that were damaged or defective prior to the time of sale
- 10 and where the purchaser was not notified of the damage or defect
- 11 in writing prior to the time of sale by the merchant shall
- 12 include all shipping and handling charges paid to the merchant
- 13 by the purchaser for delivery of the goods."
- 14 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 15 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 16 begun before its effective date.
- 17 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.



SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
