A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO OFFENSES AGAINST PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTI	ON 1. Section 710-1063, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended to	read as follows:
3	"§710	0-1063 Unsworn falsification to authorities. (1) A
4	person com	nmits the offense of unsworn falsification to
5	authoritie	es if, with an intent to mislead a public servant in
6	the perfor	rmance of the public servant's duty, the person:
7	(a)	Makes any statement, in written, printed, or
8		electronic form, which the person does not believe to
9		be true, in an application for any pecuniary or other
10		benefit or in a record or report required by law to be
11		submitted to any governmental agency;
12	<u>(b)</u>	Knowingly makes a false statement, in oral, written,
13		printed, or electronic form, to a county inspector in
14		the course of the inspector's investigation to
15		ascertain compliance with any ordinance, rule, or
16		regulation;

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1	[(b)] <u>(c)</u> Submits or invites reliance on any statement,
2	document, or record, in written, printed, or
3	electronic form, which the person knows to be falsely
4	made, completed, or altered; or
5	[(c)] <u>(d)</u> Submits or invites reliance on any sample,
6	specimen, map, boundary-mark, or other object the
7	person knows to be false.
8	(2) Unsworn falsification to authorities is a misdemeanor.
9	(3) As used in this section, "county inspector" means a
10	person employed, contracted, or appointed by a county or a
11	department or agency within a county to evaluate or investigate
12	compliance with county ordinances, rules, or regulations."
13	SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
14	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
15	SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
16	matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
17	begun before its effective date.
18	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
