A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO COUNTY LIFEGUARD LIABILITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 663, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 3 and to read as follows:
- 4 Exception to liability for county lifeguard
- 5 services. (a) For the purpose of this section:
- 6 "County lifeguard" means a person employed as a lifeguard
- 7 by a county of the State.
- 8 "Employing county" means the county employing a county
- 9 lifequard.
- Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, a 10
- 11 county lifeguard, the employing county, and the State shall not
- **12** be liable for any civil damages resulting from any act or
- 13 omission of the lifeguard while providing rescue, resuscitative,
- 14 or other lifequard services on the beach or in the ocean in the
- 15 scope of employment as a county lifequard. This exception from
- 16 liability shall not apply when the claim for civil damages



- 1 results from a county lifeguard's gross negligence or wanton act
- 2 or omission."
