A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FIREWORKS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the fireworks
- 2 display permit fee, which authorizes licensed pyrotechnicians to
- 3 conduct outdoor and close proximity fireworks for special public
- 4 or private events and theatrical or movie purposes, has remained
- 5 the same for fourteen years, but the cost to process, review,
- 6 and approve display permits has increased. The legislature also
- 7 finds that fees need to keep pace with governmental
- 8 administrative costs.
- 9 The purpose of this Act to raise the fireworks display permit
- 10 fee from \$110 to \$300.
- 11 SECTION 2. Section 132D-10, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 12 amended to read as follows:
- 13 "§132D-10 Permits. A permit shall be required for the
- 14 purchase and use of:
- 15 (1) Any consumer fireworks commonly known as firecrackers
- upon payment of a fee of \$25;
