- 8 conflict with the constitutional rights of the defendant.
- 9 (b) [Neither the] Except as provided in section 801D-

- 11 carry out the requirements of this [section nor compliance]
- chapter or failure to comply with [it shall] any of its
- 13 provisions may subject the state or county officer or employee
- 14 to liability in any civil action. [However, such failure] The
- 15 <u>failure</u> may <u>also</u> provide a basis for [such] disciplinary action
- 16 as may be deemed appropriate by competent authority."
