## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TORT LIABILITY.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 663, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately
- 3 designated and to read as follows:
- 4 "§663- Exception to liability for county lifeguard
- 5 services. (a) As used in this section:
- 6 "County lifeguard" means a person employed as a lifeguard
- 7 by a county of this State.
- 8 "Employing county" means the county employing a county
- 9 lifequard.
- 10 (b) Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, neither
- 11 a county lifequard, the employing county, nor the State shall be
- 12 liable for any civil damages resulting from any act or omission
- 13 of the lifeguard while providing rescue, resuscitative, or other
- 14 lifequard services on the beach or in the ocean in the scope of
- 15 employment as a county lifequard. This exception from
- 16 liability, however, shall not apply when the claim for civil

- 1 damages results from a county lifeguard's gross negligence or
- wanton act or omission."
- 3 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 4 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 5 begun before its effective date.
- 6 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 7 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
