- 1 SECTION 1. Section 346-156, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

- 3 "§346-156 Penalty. (a) Any person [violating any

- 7 (1) Up to [\$1,000] \$5,000 for the first violation; and

- (b) In addition to the penalties under subsection (a), any
- 11 person who intentionally, knowingly, or recklessly violates this
- 12 chapter or any rule adopted pursuant to this chapter shall be
- 13 quilty of a misdemeanor."
- 14 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 15 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 16 begun before its effective date.
