BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 6E, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
- 2 by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to
- 3 read as follows:
- 4 "§6E- President Barack Obama markers. (a) The
- 5 department shall place historical markers in the State to
- 6 indicate significant sites in the life of President Barack
- 7 Obama, the forty-fourth President of the United States of
- 8 America.
- 9 (b) The sites shall include but are not limited to Baskin-
- 10 Robbins on King Street, Island Snow, Kapiolani Medical Center
- 11 for Women and Children, Koko Crater Trail, Noelani Elementary
- 12 School, Punahou Circle Apartments, Punahou School, and Sandy
- 13 Beach; provided that no marker shall be placed at a private
- 14 business unless the business agrees to have the marker placed at
- 15 the business; if a private business does not agree, the marker
- 16 shall be placed on public property nearest to the site."
